Potter County Commissioners and Potter County 911 Dept. have developed the attached 911 addressing ordinance to formalize the partnership between your Municipality and Potter County 911. Potter County 911 has maintained and assigned addresses over the years without the formal partnership. With most recent updates of the Next Generation 911 (NG911) standards, a more formalized partnership is needed, which this ordinance would provide. This partnership would identify Potter County 911 as the municipalities addressing authority for the functions set forth in "Section 7" of the Ordinance and would ensure all State and Federal NG911 addressing requirements and standards are met for each Municipality. Potter County 911 has and will continue to maintain a GIS database of all current and future NG911 road center lines, address data points, Provisioning Boundaries and 911 Public Safety Answering Point Boundaries (PSAP Boundaries) to ensure the standardization of the NG911 requirements are maintained throughout the County.

If your Municipality chooses to adopt the Ordinance and formalize the partnership between County and Municipality, a signed copy is to be recorded with the Potter County Register & Recorders office. Please provide a copy of the recorded ordinance with the Potter County 911 office.

If your Municipality has chosen not to adopt the Ordinance, the municipality may be required to meet the obligations set forth by NENA (National Emergency Number Association) & PEMA (Pennsylvania Emergency Management Association) NG911 standards. This may include but be not limited to maintaining a NG911 compliant GIS database along with all data standards kept up to date with County, State and regional efforts and requirements.

In good faith the Potter County Commissioners have offered to reimburse costs up to \$100 to your Municipality for advertising or recording costs related to the adoption of this 911

Addressing Ordinance. You may submit a request for reimbursement to the Potter County

Commissioners with receipts of recording and advertising.
