DESCRIPTION: Tractors and machinery are involved in nearly 50% of farm deaths and disabling injuries requiring rural responders to be proficient in how to manage incidents involving this equipment whether on or off the farm. The skills the student will learn in this program can be utilized on typical machines both on the farm and in manufacturing industries, so this training program applies to non-rural emergency responders as well. Students will learn how to develop rescue strategies from various types of tractor and machinery-related incidents.

EQUIPMENT: Helmet, gloves, long pants, sturdy closed-toe footwear, safety glasses, and hearing protection. Participation will NOT be permitted without the required PPE.
