**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This is a CARRY IN – CARRY OUT Preserve – garbage, paper, bottles, cans or other waste material must be removed when you leave.

Please respect the following rules:

1. No hunting or trapping of any kind.
2. Do not injure, deface, remove, cut or damage any of the trees, plants, shrubs, turf, buildings, structures, signs, fixtures, or any other property of the Preserve.
3. Do not litter any area of the Preserve with garbage, paper, bottles, cans or other waste material.
4. Do not kindle or maintain any fire in the Preserve except in fireplaces or areas specially designated for that purpose located by authority.
5. Do not remove any bench, seat, table or other appliance without permission of authorities.
6. Do not injure, deface, destroy or remove any notice, rule or regulation posted at any place within the Preserve by authority;

nor shall any notice or placard be posted within the Preserve other than by authority of the Preserve.

7. Do not set up any booth, table or stand for the sale of any article or service whatsoever within the limits of the Preserve without permission of the authorities; distribute, sell, service or rent any services or commodity or solicit for any purpose without permission of the authority.
8. Do not bring onto the premises, possess or consume any alcoholic beverage or illegal drugs of any kind; no person shall enter the Preserve in an intoxicated state or otherwise be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
9. Do not carry or discharge any firearms, slingshots, firecrackers, fireworks or other missile propelling instruments or explosives or arrows, or other dangerous weapons which have such properties as to cause annoyance or injury to any person or property. Police officers in the performance of their duties will be exempt from these provisions.
10. Do not disturb the peace by any conduct so as to annoy any other person using the park for recreational purposes.
11. Do not operate a snowmobile, mini-bike, motorcycle, 4-wheelers, or any other recreational vehicle.
12. Pets are permitted but must be controlled at all times.
