Allegewi Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution and the Potter County Historical Society are becoming engaged and there will be many opportunities for public engagement for schools, businesses and community organizations.

Commissioner Grupp reported on the meeting between the commissioners and officials from Northcentral Pa. Regional Planning and Development Commission. Will Hunt and Kal Logue from the Planning, Community Development and GIS Department also participated. Much of the focus was on Northcentral's role in securing grants for highway and bridge projects. Northcentral can assist in other ways to support economic and community development in Potter County. She encouraged municipal officials to engage in the public participation opportunities.
